**1. Cayuga Museum – 1836
Schweinfurth Memorial
Art Center – 1981**

The Cayuga Museum building was once the home of Theodore Case, who invented sound film in his backyard laboratory. The lab is now open for tours. The Schweinfurth Art Center is named in honor of prominent 19th century architect Julius Schweinfurth.

2. St. Peter and John Church – 1870

St. Peter and John Episcopal Church cemetery contains the grave of former New York Governor Enos Throop.

3. Old Post Office – 1908

The Old Post Office Building one time served as an army depot. It is the only building of this Richardsonian - Romanesque architectural style remaining in Auburn.

4. Auburn Police Station

The Auburn police station was originally the city hall. It features a statue of former mayor of Auburn, and pioneer of prison reform, Thomas Mott Osborne in front.

5. Willard Memorial Chapel – 1894

Willard Chapel is the only complete and unaltered Tiffany chapel known to exist.

6. Hunters Dinerant – 1951

Hunters is an authentic vintage 1950s era chrome plated diner.

7. Westminster Presbyterian Church - 1861

Church began in 1861 by abolitionists. Harriet Tubman married Charles Nelson Davis in the basement chapel in 1869. Present building constructed in 1887. In 1910, Janet Seward gifted the Tiffany Rainbow Window depicting the 23rd Psalm in honor of her mother, Margaret Standart Watson.

8. YMCA-WEIU – 1825

The Auburn Women's Education and Industrial Union (WEIU) was founded by Women's Suffrage leader Eliza Osborne.

**9. Cayuga County
Court House – 1836**

The original building was topped with an enormous dome. The dome was destroyed in a fire.

10. Seymour Library – 1836

Located in the Case Memorial Building since 1903, the Seymour Library has been in operation since 1876.
